CODE OF CONDUCT

- * Parents/guardians can meet teachers only after school hours.

- * Students are allowed to go home during school hours with their parents only in case of any emergency.
- * English is expected to be the mode of communication at all levels.
- * The school takes no legal responsibility of any accidents and undue happenings occurring outside the school premises.



GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS

- * We encourage Parent-Teacher co-operation in our school.
- Parents are requested to check student's diary every day.
- Parents are requested to check their wards work and monitor in completing their work.
- * Parents are to sign the remarks given by Principal or teachers.
- * Criticism of any kind in front of the child about his educational institute is not encouraged.

ADMISSIONS

- Registration is opened from the first week of February.
- * Minimum age required for admission to class 1 is 6 years.
- * Each new applicant is required to pass the entrance exam, to be eligible for the class he/she wishes to take admission in.



ADMISSION TO CLASS XI

Applicants seeking admission to class XI Science or
Commerce stream should have passed in all the
subjects in Secondary School Examination securing
minimum 70% marks in each subject. Admission of an applicant
depends on the merit list of their aggregate marks obtained in
AISSE Examination, interview and availability of seats. The
management holds the right to take a call on what grounds it will admit or
retain the pupil in the school.
